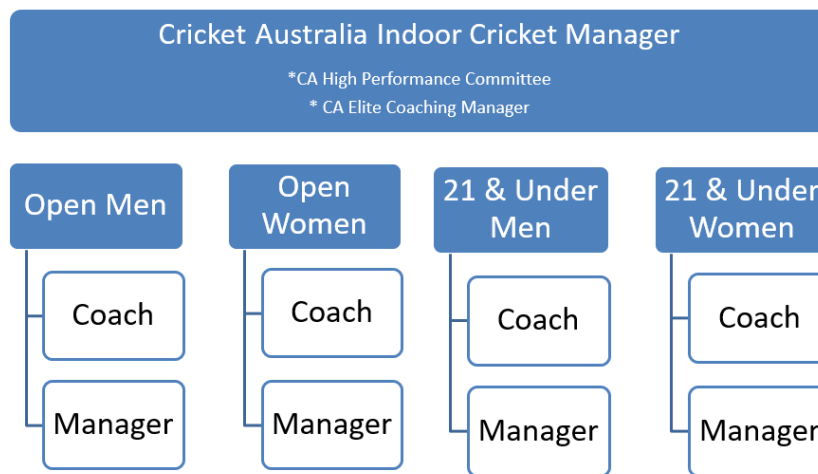


2018 – 2020 Australian Elite Indoor Cricket Coach & Management Structure

OVERVIEW

Cricket Australia are currently seeking applications for coach and management roles in our elite indoor cricket teams. With many players participating in International and National competitions, and our desire to remain World Champions, it is vital that the elite indoor coaching structure supports the development of players. The positions reflect the growing need for continuous improvement in our high-performance programs.



PROCESS

Head Coaches and Team Managers will be appointed for the Open Men, Open Women, 21 & Under Men's & 21 & Under Women's teams. Appointments will be made for a three-year term, with a 12-month probation period, leading towards the 2020 Indoor Cricket World Cup.

Indoor Cricket is played by over 185,000 Australians and is played throughout many parts of the world. It is a vital format for Cricket Australia in its objective of Cricket being Australia's favourite sport – a sport for all Australian's. A key pillar of the Australian cricket strategy is to deliver the best High Performance systems for players, with the ambition of being #1 in all formats of the game for both males and females.

The Head Coach's primary focus will be assisting in the development of players to help Australia win international events, with a complimentary focus on the seamless pathway of junior players in to the National Open team.

With demonstrated ability in developing high quality players and teams, within a framework of a team-first and quality culture environment, this position will play a pivotal role in ensuring the team remains World Champions whilst also being reflective of the spirit of all Australian cricket teams.

The successful applicants will:

- have a collaborative, innovative and flexible approach in building and developing successful teams;
- transfer and communicate a National coaching philosophy that is aligned to the Australian Cricket Pathway;
- lead the development of National Championship coaches
- develop clear goals and objectives for the team and individual player success

KEY REQUIREMENTS

Required

- coaching and/or playing experience in indoor cricket at State or National level (or at a Premier Cricket level or higher in outdoor cricket).
- previous experience in successfully developing talented players and teams
- a minimum Representative Coaching Accreditation (Level 2).
If not in place at the time of the appointment, this will need to be met within six (6) months of your appointment.

Desired

- a playing background in indoor cricket at State, National or International level
- experience in mentoring or educating individuals and/or cricket talent identification
- experience utilising the Athlete Management System (AMS)

KEY SKILLS

- strong communication, interpersonal and management skills
- team first approach
- ability to develop effective working relationships with State / Territory indoor cricket coaches, to ensure player objectives are met in the lead up to and following national duties.

GENERAL

Australian teams must be viewed as positive ambassadors for the sport & Cricket Australia at all times

Applicants will need to be available to attend all scheduled Indoor Cricket National Championship events and International tours or training camps. The successful candidate will also be required to act as the Chairman of Selectors for all International Australian team selections.
